

### **Registered Behavior Technician Training**

**Note:** Before we begin, please note that this presentation module and all the information contained therein was made effective October 2019. It is likely that changes to the registered behavior technician standards, eligibility requirements, scope of practice, and other related RBT information will change overtime. For this reason, a thorough review of Behavior Analysis Certification Board website is necessary to ensure you are aware of all current registered behavior technician requirements.

<ol> <li>Four credential overseen by BACB</li> <li>BCBA-D:Has earned a doctorate degree in a related field and is already a board certified behavior analyst (BCBA). The most advanced credential is the Board Certified Behavior Analyst Doctoral or BCBA-D. Someone who holds the BCBA-D credential has earned a doctorate degree in a related field and is already a board certified behavior analyst.</li> <li>BCBA- has earned masters in related field including class work in ABA. Completed training and supervision hours. Passed BCBA exam. May practice independently and act as supervisors towards those working towards these credentials</li> <li>BCABA has earned a Bachelor's degree, completed ABA coursework, training and supervision hours and passed BCABA exam. BCABA cannot practice independently must be supervised by a BCBA or BCBA-D, but may supervise RBT</li> <li>Registered Behavior Technician To be eligible must be:         <ul> <li>a. RBTs must maintain appropriate boundaries when working with clients. Examples include conversing only about, sharingabout your personal life and engaging inwith the client. If I have questions about what is acceptable and not acceptable, I should seek from in a timely manner.
The BACB created a Task List (2 <sup>nd</sup> edition) of core skills and tasks I should be willing and prepared to perform. Review task list and website to be familiar with your role as an RBT.

Tasks fall into 6 categories

As an RBT you may be trained and asked to complete some of these assessments during your sessions with clients or students. You may also be asked to assist your supervisor or other clinicians with more in-depth lengthier assessments.

In addition, the BACB holding the Registered Behavior Technician certification requires you to comply with applicable legal, regulatory, and workplace data collection, storage, transportation, and documentation requirements.
6. Professional conduct and scope of practice includes:
<ul> <li>What my role allows me to do and not do</li> <li>Able to receive feedback in a profession manner and actively seeking clinical direction from supervisor in a timely manner.</li> <li>Willingness to work toward towards professional improvement</li> <li>Maintain professional relationships with all parties from work environments</li> <li>Ability to communicate effectively and respectfully with client's, caregivers, supervisors, coworkers</li> </ul>
RBT does <b>NOT</b> :  • Design teaching procedures or behavior plans supervisor designs these.  • Do not make any changes in teaching procedures or behavior plans  • Discuss questions with supervisor  • Complete only tasks assigned to you



#### The Role of the RBT Supervisor

- The BCBA or BCaBA, or other licensed profession supervisor assigns tasks and responsibilities assigns tasks and responsibilities based on my the RBT level of experience and training
- Design and write up all skill acquisition and behavior reduction procedures and share with RBT
- Supervisor is responsible to provide training in these procedures so the RBT can effectively implement successfully.
- The supervisor and RBT must be employed by the same organization OR the supervisor must have a contractual relationship with the client.

#### **RBT Requirements Coordinator**

Another person who plays a role in the practice of the RBT is the Requirements Coordinator. The individual hold either a BCBA-D or BCBA and has completed specific supervision requirement outline by the BACB.

All RBTS must have a Requirements Coordinator who is registered as such with the Behavior Analysis Certification Board.

The Requirements Coordinator has a different role than the supervisor. He or she is responsible for making sure that the RBT has a BCBA supervisor.

You are required to have a registered Requirements Coordinator for each place you are employed.

This means if you work as an RBT for two different organizations, you will have two different Requirements Coordinators registered with the BACB.

#### **Maintaining the RBT Credentials**
